

**Allegory (Gal. iv. 24).**

It is sometimes urged by those who oppose the historic accuracy of the O.T. that even Paul admitted that the incident concerning Sarah and Hagar and the birth of Ishmael, was but an allegory. It is well to be accurate when dealing with the Word of God, and to remember that the Apostle did not say that the incidents themselves were “but allegories” but *ha tina estin allegoroumena* = “which is allegorizing”, i.e., referring to his own use of the historic incidents.
