1. Present heaven and earth created. (Gen.1)

2. Genesis written by Moses who looks back to 7 day Creation week. (Gen. 1)

3. Creation week emphasizes evening and morning of each day. (Gen. 1)

4. Darkness over the face of the deep (original:abyss) . Satan loose and deceives woman. Gen. 1:2, Gen. 3

5. Sea: darkness over it (Gen. 1:2-3)

6. Heavens spread out like curtain. (Gen1:6-8, Isa. Isa. 40:22)

7. Sin, sorrow, and death enter. (Gen 3)

8. Paradise lost (Gen. 3)

9. Access to Tree of Life forfeited (Gen.3)

10. God walks in garden in midst of man. (Gen. 3:8)

11. 1st martyr: Abel (Gen. 4:8, Matt. 23:35)

12. Babel (Babylon) begins: Mother of all false religions (Gen.11)

13. Earthly Jerusalem introduced: Melchizedek, King of Salem (Gen. 14:18)

14. Pharaoh, king who does not know God, oppresses God's people (Exo.5:2)

15. 2 witness bring the Lord's plagues (Exo. 6:6)

16. Deliverance of God's people promised and wrought with a mighty Hand (Exo. 5-11)

17. Tabernacle and later temple introduced as a picture of Christ (Exo. 25- 40)

18. Faithful few enter into the promise land (Num. 14:22-24)

1. New heaven and new earth created. (Rev. 21:1)

2. John looks forward and sees 7 seals, 7 trumpets, & 7 vials. Rev. 5:5, 8:1, 5:7

3. 7 sets of plagues emphasize "in heaven and on earth" (Rev. 5-17)

4. Satan is bound and thrown into abyss. (Rev. 20:1-3)

5. No more sea. (Rev. 21:1)

6. Heavens rolled up like scroll. (Rev.6:14)

7. No more sin, sorrow and death for faithful (Rev. 21:3-5)

8. Paradise restored (Rev. 21-22)

9. Access to Tree of Life restored (Rev. 2:7, 22:2)

10. God dwells in midst of His people (Rev. 21:3)

11. Last martyrs: overcomers (Rev. 20:4)

12. Babylon ends (Rev.18)

13. Heavenly Jerusalem introduced. (Rev. 21:10-27)

14. Antichrist oppresses God's people (Rev. 13:7)
